Roadside Land Prices Increases Are Slowing Down (7/2)

In January 1, 2024, Japan's National Tax Agency had announced 5.2% roadside land price increase affecting 14,000 areas, which is lower compared to 6.8% last year. The price increase has continued for 9 years, however as of recent, the price increase have been slowing down putting Hokkaido at 4th place for roadside land price increase nationwide. Despite the economical developments, many cities in the region are seeing a fall in land price.

Admission Tax Under Consideration for Biei's Blue Pond (7/10)

Biei is considering an admission tax for their widely popular tourist destination"Blue Pond" (Aoi Ike). They hope that adding an admission tax would curb the overtourism taking place in the area. Currently the site charges 500 yen per parked car at the park, however with the increasing number of tourists, they hope that it would be a source of funds. They hope to implement this in 2026 and if implemented would be the first of its kind in Hokkaido.

Beer Gardens Brimming with Individuality (7/17)

Since the beginnning of July, many beer gardens have open downtown from Art Hotel to Asahikawa Station. Many stores are offering more than 33 kinds of Nihonshu in addition to beer and wine. Furthermore, to attract non-drinkers, many beer gardens also offer non-alcoholic sparkling beverages for everyone to enjoy. The opening of several beer gardens for the summer season as well as promotion of local sake have led to an increase of foot traffic in the city both domestic and abroad.

Amending Summer Break for Schools in Hokkaido (7/23)

With the rising temperatures in Hokkaido, many parents are concerned on its impacts to school children with worries of heat stroke during commute, as well as school due to lack of air conditioning. As a result, different municipalities and local governments have opted to amend their summer breaks by prolonging summer vacation. Ultimately many Hokkaido schools seem to increase their overall summer and winter breaks, going from 50 days from the 2023 fiscal year to 56 days for 2024.

Students fromKorea Visit the National Institute of Technology, Asahikawa College (7/27)

Students from Suwon Hi-Tech High School, Korea has visited the National Institude of Technology, Asahikawa College as well as visited city hall. Since the agreement for scholastic exchange between both schools in 2009, there have been students mutually sent to both schools in the last 10 years. In addition to attending classes, the students were able to check out various local sights such as the Asahiyama Zoo and Kitasaito Garden.
